To be eligible to vote in a Provincial election, a person must be: (1) a Canadian citizen; (2) at least 18 years of age or more on polling day; (3) ordinarily resident in the Province immediately preceding polling day; and (4) ordinarily resident in an electoral district and polling division on polling day as determined by the Rules of Residency prescribed by the Elections Act, 1991 Chapter E-3.1 SNL 1992.
