OATH FOR VOTING BY AN ELECTION OFFICER OR SCRUTINEER
(Section 99)



**If an Election Officer or Scrutineer wishes to vote on polling day, they are permitted to vote at the poll where they are working, using this oath. Election Officers and Scrutineers must meet the qualifications of an elector in order to vote. If a Deputy Returning Officer uses this oath to vote, the form must be witnessed (signed) by a Deputy Returning Officer from another poll, the Returning Officer or a Commissioner for Oaths.*
