- ADM Gogan provided an overview of the proposal and the approach, including benefit levels and other design elements, estimated cost and administrative model.
- Committee members discussed the potential advantages and disadvantages of the proposed approach, and how the report can inform work in NL.

3. Federal Engagement

- The Chair circulated a draft letter to Minister Karina Gould (Families, Children and Social Developemnt) from the All Party Committee regarding federal cooperation on a basic income program in NL.
- Members were asked to review and provide feedback early the next week. The letter draft will be provided to member Pardy.
- The Chair indicated he has spoken with MP Sean Casey (PEI), who co-chairs the federal anti-poverty caucus with Senator Kim Pate (Ontario) regarding potentially meeting to discuss basic income.

4. Document on existing Income Benefits

 The Chair circulated a document that MHA Gambin-Walsh requested. The document provides an overview of existing federal and provincial income benefits, the minimum income that different family sizes and types receive and how these income levels compare to the relevant low-income thresholds.
