Income and Employment Support

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	 Where utilities are included in a rental or mortgage arrangement, the appropriate deductions must be made from the family/individual benefits requirement. A 'utilities' requirement can be added to the Income Support allowance where the rental amount being charged is higher than the basic rental rate. This requirement is an "up to" rate so the maximum may not be required. Where heat is included in the rent/mortgage, there is no eligibility for the fuel supplement.
