Personal information contained on this form is collected under the authority of the *Vital Statistics Act, 2009*. The Information provided will be used to fulfill the requirements of the *Vital Statistics Act* for the release of marriage and death Information. If you have any questions about the collection or use of this information, please contact a Vital Statistics representative at (709) 729-3308.

Who is entitled to apply for a marriage certificate?

- The person is at least 19 years of age.
- Either party to the marriage.
- A designated person who has known the person making the designation for at least one year and has signed a statement to that effect in the form set by the minister.
- Satisfies the registrar general that they are acting on behalf of or employed by a government, charitable or non-profit organization providing social support or social services to the person making the designation and has signed a statement to that effect in the form set by the minister.
- A person with an order from the Court.
- When one or both parties to the marriage are deceased, the registrar general may issue a certificate of marriage or certified copy of registration of marriage to the child, parent or executor or administrator of the deceased party's estate, or to another relative of the deceased party where there is no child or parent (proof of death is required).

Who is entitled to apply for a death certificate?

- Any person may apply for a death certificate.

Identification required

Any person applying for a certificate is required to present acceptable identification - one piece of photo ID or two pieces of other ID, at least one of which contains their signature or address. A person who has written authorization to apply for or pick up someone else's certificate is required to present their own ID. Persons applying by mail are required to submit photocopies of their ID documents.

To avoid delay

Complete the appropriate section in full (All requests with incomplete information must be accompanied by a written explanation for the omission.)

Payment must be enclosed with the application and can be either by cheque or money order (Canadian Funds) payable to the Newfoundland Exchequer Account.

Be sure your address and telephone number are correct and are clearly printed.

Please indicate whether you wish to receive your certificate by mail or will pick it up.

Marriage Certificates

Long form only is available and contains the name of each party to the marriage, date of marriage, place of marriage, registration number, registration date, and date issued.

Death Certificates

Long form only is available and contains the name, date of death, place of death, age, sex, registration number, registration date, marital status and date issued.

Certificates contain information extracted from the original registration filed in our office.
