Temporary License for Insurance Adjusters

On September 27, 2022 the Office of the Superintendent of Insurance commenced accepting requests for Temporary Insurance Adjuster Licenses to expedite the licensing of insurance adjusters responding to claims resulting from Hurricane Fiona (see Bulletin Issue No. 34 – September 2022).

As of November 15, 2022, the Office of the Superintendent of Insurance will cease accepting new requests for Temporary Insurance Adjuster Licenses pursuant to claims emerging from Hurricane Fiona.

Requests for extensions to existing Temporary Insurance Adjuster Licenses issued from September 27, 2022 to November 14, 2022 must be submitted in writing to the Office of the Superintendent of insurance and will be considered on a case by case basis.
