Forest Fire Ban Proclamation under the Forestry Act

(Filed April 21, 2020)

Under the authority of section 99 of the *Forestry Act*, I proclaim a fire ban in all areas of the province.

Fire ban

- **1.** The fire ban prohibits the setting of fires on forest land or within 300 metres of forest land in all areas of the province.
- (2) The fire ban shall not apply to the setting of fires for the following purposes:
 - (a) agriculture;
 - (b) silviculture; or

- (c) fire services training.
- (3) Notwithstanding subsection (2), a person shall not set a fire for a purpose referred to in paragraph (2)(a), (b) or (c) during the period of the ban unless the person has obtained the written permission of a forestry official from the forest management district where the fire will take place.

Duration of ban

2. The fire ban shall remain in force until 11:59 p.m. September 30, 2020.
