NOTICE OF REGISTRATION TOWN OF LABRADOR CITY DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENTS No. 1-6 & 8, 2020

TAKE NOTICE that the TOWN OF LABRADOR CITY DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENTS NO. 1-6 & 8, 2020 as adopted on the 15th day of September, 2020, have been registered by the Minister of Environment, Climate Change and Municipalities.

IN GENERAL TERMS, the purpose of DRA-01-2020 is to introduce new definitions for 'Deck', 'Patio', 'Pergola' and 'Accessibility Ramp'. In addition to the foregoing, the amendment includes criteria to allow 'accessibility ramps' to project into restricted development areas;

DRA-02-2020 introduces a definition for 'Portable Office Trailer', amends the existing definition for 'Outdoor Storage' and details acceptable zones where storage is permitted;

DRA-03-2020 proposes a minor change to the definition of a 'Seasonal Residence', establishing a correlation to the use class 'Single Dwelling';

DRA-04-2020 introduces a new definition and accompanying images for 'Street Intersection' to clarify administration of the existing regulations. In addition, this Amendment adjusts the metrics for vehicular accesses on local, collector and arterial streets;

DRA-05-2020 includes criteria for attached accessory buildings that differentiates administration from detached buildings. Additionally, this Amendment introduces criteria

for accessory buildings in zones where standards are otherwise absent;

DRA-06-2020 updates the definition of 'Backlot' as well its associated image, which clarifies that the backlot is integral to the primary land parcel. Also included are adjustments to the development criteria for garden suites, which includes a reduction of the maximum length of a driveway access, an increase to the minimum building separation distance and the prohibition of subsidiary apartments within the same lot; and,

DRA-08-2020 amends general lot development standards for residential; lots intended for residential purposes shall not have a depth exceeding four times the frontage; and, residential lots shall not abut a local street at both front and rear lot lines.

CNLR 1162/96 **1. Subsection 7.1(4) of the** *Liquor Licensing Regulations* is repealed and the following substituted:

- (4) A person shall not deliver alcoholic liquor to
- (a) a person that is under 19 years of age;
- (b) a person that appears intoxicated; or
- (c) a place where alcoholic liquor is not permitted to be purchased or possessed.

2. The regulations are amended by adding immediately after section 7.1 the following:

Delivery service licence

Suspension of licence

7.2 (1) A delivery service licence may be issued to the owner or operator of a delivery service which is maintained, equipped and operated in a manner approved by the board.

(2) A delivery service licence authorizes the licensee or an employee of the licensee to deliver alcoholic liquor in accordance with section 7.1 to persons who purchase a meal prepared by a licensee authorized under subsection 27(7) of the Act from the licensed premises.

3. Subsection 55(1) of the regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

55. (1) An inspector generally or specially authorized by the board may suspend a licence for a period not exceeding 30 days where in his or her opinion the licensed premises or an activity to which the licence relates is not being operated or conducted in accordance with the Act or these regulations or the conditions prescribed in or in respect of such licence.
