### **NOTICE OF INTENT, SECTION 7 LANDS ACT, SNL1991 c36 AS AMENDED**

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that an application has been made to the Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture Branch, to acquire title, pursuant to section 7(2) (d) of the said Act, to that piece of Crown lands situated within 15 metres of the waters of Harbour Drive, Harbour Main-Chapels Cove-Lakeview, for the purpose of installing a slipway and breakwater.
