TAKE NOTICE that the St. John's Municipal Council has enacted the RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY STANDARDS (AMENDMENT NO. 1-2021) BY-LAW.

THE SAID BY-LAW was passed by Council on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2021, so as to clarify that parking of vehicles on the front yard of a residential property is prohibited.
