1. This Order may be cited as the *Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited Exemption Order No. 2.*

Exemption – Electrical Power Control Act, 1994 **2.** Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited is exempt from subsection 14.1(1) of the *Electrical Power Control Act, 1994* for all aspects of its activities respecting the purchase of electrical power and energy from Nalcor Energy Marketing.

Exemption – Public Utilities Act

3. Corner Brook Pulp and Paper is exempt from subsection 70(1) of the *Public Utilities Act* for all aspects of its activities respecting the return of electrical power and energy to Nalcor Energy Marketing, to a maximum of 105 MW, at a rate of \$0.
