#### GREETING:

#### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 20 of An Act to Amend the *Adoption Act*, 2013, Statutes of Newfoundland and Labrador 2021 Chapter 22 (the "Act"), it is provided that the Act comes into force on a day to be proclaimed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall now come into force;

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that An Act to Amend the *Adoption Act*, 2013, Statutes of Newfoundland and Labrador 2021 Chapter 22, shall come into force on October 28th, 2022.

1. The *Adoption Regulations*, 2014 are amended by adding immediately after section 14 the following:

#### PART II.1 INDIGENOUS REPRESENTATIVE

Indigenous representative

- **14.1** (1) An Indigenous government or organization may designate one or more Indigenous representatives.
- (2) Where an Indigenous government or organization designates one or more Indigenous representatives it shall notify the minister, in writing, of the name of each Indigenous representative.
- (3) An Indigenous representative designated under subsection (1) may designate a person as an acting Indigenous representative to perform the duties of the Indigenous representative where the Indigenous representative is absent or unable to act.
- (4) Where an acting Indigenous representative is designated under subsection (3),
  - (a) the Indigenous representative shall notify the Indigenous government or organization of the designation and the time period in which the person designated will be acting as the Indigenous representative; and
  - (b) the Indigenous government or organization shall immediately provide that information to the minister in writing.
- (5) Where an Indigenous government or organization replaces a person appointed under subsection (1), the Indigenous government or organization shall immediately notify the minister, in writing of the change.

Commencement

2. These regulations come into force on the day the *Act to Amend the Adoption Act, 2013* comes into force.

- (3) Notwithstanding subsection 14(1) and paragraph 2(b), the monthly amount of income support for a single person under the age of 30 years who, as determined by an officer, has barriers or impairments which limit that person's pursuit of employment or training is \$532.
