

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 40 of An Act to Amend the *Medical Act*, 2011, Statutes of Newfoundland and Labrador 2022 Chapter 21 (the "Act"), it is provided that this Act, or a section, subsection or paragraph of it, except section 38, comes into force on a day or days to be proclaimed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall now come into force, with the exception of section 12;

NOW KNOW YE,THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that An Act to Amend the *Medical Act, 2011,* Statutes of Newfoundland and Labrador 2022 Chapter 21, with the exception of section 12, shall come into force on May 1, 2023.

1. S.22 R&S Minimum price for milk

NLR 69/98 as amended 1. Section 22 of the *Milk Regulations*, 1998 is repealed and the following substituted:

Minimum price for milk

22. The minimum price at which milk shall be bought, sold or offered for sale FOB registered processors premises in the province shall be \$137.95 per hectoliter of standard milk containing 3.6 kilograms of butterfat, and for every kilogram in excess of that butterfat content, the minimum price shall be adjusted by the amount of \$5.20 per hectoliter.
