Subject: Breach of Material Term Chapter: Notice of Termination

Legislation	s. 20
Definitions	Material term: any condition which is of specific relevance to the rental agreement.
Purpose	The purpose of this policy is to outline options for a landlord and a tenant where a breach of a material term or condition occurs.
Policy	A landlord or tenant who commits a material breach may be given written notice of the breach by the other party and identify a reasonable time for the breach to be corrected. Where the landlord or tenant fails to remedy the breach within a reasonable time after receiving the notice, the other party may terminate the rental agreement early for cause. Where the premises are rented monthly, or for a fixed term or are a site for a mobile home, not less than one month before the end of the rental period; Where the premises are rented weekly, not less than one week before the end of the rental period. (Refer to legislation).
Procedure Overview	A material term or condition may include but is not limited to the following examples: No smoking; No pets; Pay own utilities; Internet included in rent Washer and dryer included in rent A breach of a material term or condition occurs when either the landlord or the tenant fails to abide by the term or condition of the rental agreement. Where a landlord or a tenant commits a material breach, the other party may give written notice of the breach and identify a reasonable time for the breach to be remedied.





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	If the party fails to remedy the breach, the other party may give notice to terminate the rental agreement for cause as follows: • not less than one month before the end of the rental period where the premises are rented from month to month or for a fixed term or a site for a mobile home; or
	 not less than one week before the end of the rental period. where the premises are rented week to week.
