Policy	A landlord should inspect the rental premises periodically during the course of any tenancy (after serving the appropriate notice to enter). Landlords and tenants both have the right to keep records of the condition of the premises. Rental premises condition report forms should be used at the beginning and termination of the tenancy to protect the rights of all parties. Landlords and tenants should note that date and time stamped video and/or pictures of property conditions and damage serve as important evidence in the resolution of any possible dispute. Written notice to enter must be given by the landlord to the tenant prior to inspection of the unit.
