Fees

Registration Fees

1. An application for registration of a pension plan required under Section 18(1) of the Act and Directive No. 1 shall be accompanied by a fee of \$10.00 for each member and \$5.00 for each former member of the pension plan. The total fee payable under this paragraph shall not be less than \$200 or more than \$12,500.

Annual Information Return

- 2. An annual information return required under Section 16 of the Act shall accompanied by a fee of \$10.00 for each member and \$5.00 for each former member of the pension plan. The total fee payable under this paragraph shall not be less than \$200 or more than \$12,500.
- 3. Where the annual information return is delivered to the Superintendent after the time period required in Section 3 of the *Pension Benefits Act Regulations* or Section 60(2)(b) of the Act, the fee payable under paragraph 2 shall be doubled and the total fee payable shall not be less than \$400 or more than \$25,000.

Retirement Savings Arrangements

4. Each savings institution or insurance company that has at least one retirement savings arrangement, as defined under Directive No. 3, on the Superintendent's lists on January 1st of a calendar year shall pay a fee of \$500 per institution or company for that calendar year.
