A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS Her Excellency the Governor General in Council by Commission under the Great Seal of Canada, bearing the date the twenty eighth day of January in the year of Our Lord, two thousand and eight and in the Fifty-sixth Year of Her Majesty's Reign, has been pleased to appoint me to be the Lieutenant Governor in and for the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador during the will and pleasure of the Governor General of Canada;

NOW KNOW YE that I have thought fit to publish and make known and do hereby publish and make known that I have this day made and subscribed the Oaths of Allegiance and Office and assumed the duties of my office as Lieutenant Governor, under and in accordance with the Governor General's Commission and Instructions and the statutes and laws in that behalf, and I do hereby require and command that each and every person holding any office, place, employment or function under Her Majesty in this Province do continue in the execution thereof.

OF ALL WHICH Her Majesty's subjects in this Province and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
