TAKE NOTICE that the Town of Labrador City, Development Regulations Amendment No. 7, 2001, adopted on the 27th day of March, 2001, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment No. 7, 2001, is to change the Development Standards under Use Zone Tables under the Central Business District as follows:

1. a) Minimum building line setback 4 metres
b) Maximum height 15 metres
c) Either the rearyard depth or sideyard width shall be minimum of 4 metres while the other shall conform to those as specified in the R1 Zone.

2. i) Discretionary Use Classes, apartment building and commercial residential, development standards shall conform to those as specified in the R1 Zone.

ii) Where apartments face each other without a street in between, they shall be no closer than twenty-one (21) metres.

The Development Regulations Amendment No. 7, 2001 comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland Gazette*. 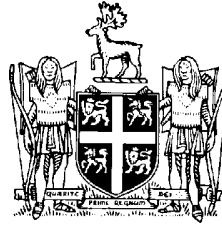
