ST. JOHN'S DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NUMBER 238, 2001

TAKE NOTICE that the City of St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 238, 2001 adopted and approved on the 4th day of June 2001, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms the purpose of St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 238, 2001, is to amend the text of the St. John's Development Regulations to make provision for the reconstruction of the food bank building in the flood plain of the Waterford River behind the Corpus Christi Church on Waterford Bridge Road.

St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 238, 2001 comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland Gazette*. NOTICE OF REGISTRATION ST. JOHN'S MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT NUMBER 131, 2000 AND

ST. JOHN'S DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NUMBER 230, 2000

TAKE NOTICE that the City of St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 131, 2000 and St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 230, 2000, adopted on the 20th day of November 2000, and approved on the 28th day of May 2001, have been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms the purpose of St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 131, 2000, is to redesignate part of the land located between Newtown Road and Bonaventure Avenue, and referred to as the Belvedere Property, from the Public Land Use District to the Residential Medium Density Land Use District and the Commercial General Land Use District and to limit building heights under the Commercial General Land Use District for the Belvedere Property to three (3) storeys.

In general terms the purpose of St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 230, 2000 is to rezone part of the Belvedere Property from the Public (P) Zone to the Residential High Density (R3) Zone, the Commercial Office (CO) Zone, and the Apartment Low Density (A1) Zone, and to restrict building heights under the Commercial Office (CO) Zone at the Belvedere Property to three (3) storeys.

The St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 131, 2000 and St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 230, 2000 come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland Gazette*.
