In general terms the purpose of St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 136, 2001 is to redesignate a portion of the land situated in the area of the intersection of Newfoundland Drive & East White Hills Road from the Residential Medium Density (RMD) District to the Public (P) District and redesignate a portion of the land situated in the area of the intersection of Newfoundland Drive & East White Hills Road from the Public (P) District of the Residential Medium Density (RMD) District.

In general terms the purpose of St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 237, 2001, is to rezone from the Rural (R) Zone to Public (P) Zone and the Residential Medium Density (R2) Zone a parcel of land situated in the area of the intersection of Newfoundland Drive & East White Hills Road.

The St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 136, 2001 and St. John's Development Regulations Amendment No. 237, 2001 come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland Gazette*. Proclamation bringing the Act into force (SN2001 cM20.2) (July 1/01) under the *Municipal Elections Act* (O.C. 2001-315)

# TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

### GREETING;

### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 106 of the *Municipal Elections Act*, S.N. 2001, cM-20.2, (the "Act"), it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant-Governor in Council;
