### NOTICE OF APPROVAL

TAKE NOTICE that the Honourable Oliver Langdon, Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs, under and by virtue of the powers conferred by the *Urban and Rural Planning Act*, has approved as the Mount Pearl Municipal Plan Amendment No. 42, 2000, Centennial Square Development Scheme 2000 and the Mount Pearl Development Regulations Amendment No. 107, 2000, the amendments made and adopted by the Mount Pearl City Council on the 21<sup>st</sup> of August, 2000, described below.

In general terms, the purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment No. 42, 2000 includes Centennial Square Development Scheme 2000 as part of the Mount Pearl Municipal Plan. Centennial Square Development Scheme 2000 provides detailed direction for development of and investment in the Square.

In general terms, the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment No. 107, 2000 is to rezone the area generally located south of Park Avenue, east of Commonwealth Avenue and fronting onto Centennial and Bannister Streets from Commercial General (GC) to City Centre (CC). A City Centre Zone Table establishing development standards for this zone is also added to the Mount Pearl Development Regulations.

For the actual wording and location of the Municipal Plan Amendment and the Development

Regulations Amendment, the approved amendment documents should be consulted.

Municipal Plan Amendment No. 42, 2000, Centennial Square Development Scheme 2000 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 107, 2000 come into effect on the day of publication of this notice in *The Newfoundland Gazette*, and any person who wishes to inspect a copy of them may do so at the City of Mount Pearl or at the Urban and Rural Planning Division, Department of Municipal and Provincial Affairs, Confederation Building West Block, St. John's, Newfoundland.

## NEWFOUNDLAND REGULATION 52/01

*Smoke-free Environment Regulations (Amendment)*  
under the  
*Smoke-free Environment Act*  
(O.C. 2001-372)

*(Filed July 30, 2001)*

Under the authority of section 12 of the *Smoke-free Environment Act*, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council makes the following regulations.

**1. Section 2 of the *Smoke-free Environment Regulations* is amended by deleting the word "and" at the end of paragraph (b), deleting the period at the end of paragraph (c) and substituting a semi-colon and the word "and" and by adding immediately after paragraph (c) the following:**

- (d) "liquor licence" means a licence issued under the *Liquor Licensing Regulations* made under the *Liquor Control Act*.

**2. The regulations are amended by adding immediately after section 10 the following:**

Food establishments

**11.** (1) An owner of a food establishment shall not permit smoking in that food establishment

- (a) where that food establishment does not have a liquor licence;
- (b) where that food establishment has a motel, hotel, tourist home, restaurant, military mess, institution, transportation services, airport establishment or recreational facility liquor licence; and
- (c) during the hours that persons under the age 19 years are permitted in that food establishment where that food establishment has a club, lounge or special events liquor licence.

(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1)(c), an owner of a food establishment that has both a restaurant and a lounge liquor licence shall not permit smoking in that food establishment between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 8:30 p.m.

Public places open to minors

**12.** An owner of a public place that is

- (a) a boys and girls club;
- (b) a games arcade;
- (c) a shopping mall;
- (d) a common area of a hotel, motel or convention centre;
- (e) an air, bus, or marine passenger vessel terminal; or
- (f) a public library

that is open to persons under the age of 19 years shall not permit smoking in that public place.

Commencement

**3. These regulations shall come into force on January 1, 2002.**
