Workplace Health, Safety and Compensation Regulations (Amendment) under the Workplace Health, Safety and Compensation Act (O.C. 2001 - 463)

CNR 1025/96 as amended

1. Subsection 16(1) of the Workplace Health, Safety and Compensation Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

Educational institutions **16.** (1) For the purpose of paragraph 2(1)(i) of the Act, the following are educational institutions:

- (a) Memorial University of Newfoundland;
- (b) College of the North Atlantic;
- (c) Centre for Nursing Studies, Health Care Corporation of St. John's;
- (d) Western Regional School of Nursing, Western Health Care Corporation; and
- (e) a school as defined by the Schools Act, 1997.
