



 - (k) "support trust" means a trust fund established for the use and benefit of a disabled adult.

- (3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2), an officer of the department may grant social assistance to a disabled adult or a family with one or more disabled adults for whose use and benefit there is a support trust provided that
 - (a) the liquid assets of the support trust do not exceed a total of \$100,000; and
 - (b) that disabled adult or family annually receives the total interest and income from the support trust plus 2% of the liquid assets of the support trust; and
 - (c) the support trust is established and maintained in a manner and under terms and conditions that the minister may establish or approve.
