TAKE NOTICE that the City of Mount Pearl Development Regulations Amendment Number 112, 2001, adopted by Council on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2001, and approved (as amended) on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2001, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment Number 112, 2001 is to change the text of the Industrial Light (LI) Use Zone. The text amendment specifically applies to Condition 10, General Assembly, Indoor Assembly, and Outdoor Assembly Uses. The Industrial Light (LI) Use Zone as amended should be referred to in order to identify more precisely the text changes covered by Amendment Number 112.

The Mount Pearl Development Regulations Amendment Number 112, 2001 comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. Anyone who wishes to inspect a copy of

### NOTICE OF REGISTRATION TOWN OF PASADENA DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO'S. 6, 7 & 8, 2001

TAKE NOTICE that the Town of Pasadena Development Regulations Amendment No. 6, 7, and 8 have been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

Amendment No. 6 adopted on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of May, 2001.

The purpose of Amendment No. 6, 2001 is to allow construction to proceed on a specific property with a sideyard within its boundary of 2.74 metres supplemented with 7.92 meters of town property. This is a one time amendment.

Amendment No. 7 adopted on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2001.

The purpose of Amendment No. 7 is to allow accessory buildings up to 3.7 metres in width to be constructed to a maximum of 3.8 metres in height, building exceeding 3.7 metres in width cannot exceed 4.5 metres in height. Front yard construction may be permitted where natural terrain conditions prohibit rear yard construction.

Amendment No. 8 adopted in the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December, 2001.

The purpose of Amendment No. 8 is to add "animal" to the discretionary uses of the class zone title Tourism/Recreation Comprehensive Development area to allow property owners to keep animals used for Commercial Tourism Ventures on their property.

The Town of Pasadena Development Regulations Amendment No. 6, 7 & 8 come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. In general terms, the purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment No. 1, is to redesignate lands on the north side of Route 220, west of the Town Hall and Soccer field for residential uses. The purpose of the corresponding Development Regulations Amendment No. 1 is to rezone this area from the Commercial Highway Use Zone to the Residential Medium Density Use Zone.

The purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment No. 2 is to revise the Rural policies of the Municipal Plan to permit development is a wind farm. The purpose of the corresponding Development Regulations Amendment No. 2 is to add "utilities" as a Discretionary Use, and a new condition for wind-generated electrical utilities, to the Rural Use Zone Table.

The purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment No. 3 is to redesignate lands to the south of the school and west of Riverside Drive to the Commercial Land Use designation. The purpose of the corresponding Development Regulations Amendment No. 3 is to rezone this area to the Commercial General Land Use Zone to permit commercial development and to add Shopping Centre as a Discretionary Use in the Commercial General Use Zone.

The St. Lawrence Municipal Plan Amendments No. 1, 2 and 3, 2001 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 1, 2 and 3, 2001 come into effect on the day that this notice is published by *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. **1.** This Order may be cited as the *Open Season Big Game Polar Bear Hunting Order, Labrador Portion, 2002*.

Prohibition Open season	<p><b>2.</b> The taking of polar bears is prohibited throughout the Labrador portion of the province except as provided for in this Order.</p> <p><b>3.</b> The open season for hunting polar bear in that portion of Labrador from Fish Cove Point in Groswater Bay to Cape Chidley shall be February 9, 2002 to June 29, 2002.</p>
Bag limit	<p><b>4.</b> The bag limit is one polar bear of either sex except that female polar bears accompanied by cubs, young of the year may not be taken.</p>
Shooting only	<p><b>5.</b> Polar bears shall only be taken by shooting.</p>
Bears in den	<p><b>6.</b> Polar bears shall not be taken in a den and active dens shall not be disturbed in any way.</p>
Bears with transmitters, etc.	<p><b>7.</b> Polar bears equipped with radio transmitters or collars shall not be taken.</p>
Repeal	<p><b>8. The <i>Open Season Big Game Polar Bear Hunting Order, Labrador, 2001</i>, Newfoundland and Labrador Regulation 17/01, is repealed.</b></p>
