

PART VIII PROFESSIONAL MEDICAL CORPORATIONS

Corporate licence

- **18.1** Registration and a corporate licence to provide the services of one or more medical practitioners shall be granted to a corporation that
 - (a) files a completed application in the form approved by the registrar, and complies with the undertakings and authorizations contained in it;
 - (b) provides to the registrar a certified copy of the articles of incorporation of the corporation;
 - (c) satisfies the registrar that the corporation complies with the requirements of the Act and these regulations relating to professional medical corporations; and
 - (d) pays the prescribed fees.

Expiry and renewal

- **18.2** A corporate licence shall be renewed by the registrar where the professional medical corporation
 - (a) is in good standing with the board;
 - (b) files a completed application for renewal in the form approved by the registrar, and complies with the undertakings and authorizations contained in it;
 - (c) satisfies the registrar that the corporation continues to comply with the requirements of the Act and these regulations relating to professional medical corporations; and

(d) pays the prescribed fees.

Notice of change

18.3 A professional medical corporation shall advise the registrar of a change in the information provided in an application for corporate licence or an application for renewal of a licence, in the form of notice of change approved by the registrar, within 15 days of the change, and shall pay the prescribed fee.

Certification of documents **18.4** All applications, notices and other documents submitted to the registrar on behalf of a professional medical corporation shall be certified by all of the licensed medical practitioners who are directors or shareholders of the corporation.

Maintenance of records

- **18.5** The registrar shall maintain a record of the following information with respect to each professional medical corporation:
 - (a) the name, registered office, medical offices and corporate number of the professional medical corporation;
 - (b) the names and residential addresses of all persons holding voting shares in the corporation, the number and class of voting shares held by each person, and the terms, conditions and restrictions applicable to the voting shares;
 - (c) the name and residential address of all persons holding non-voting shares in the corporation, the number and class of non-voting shares held by each person, and the terms and conditions applicable to the non-voting shares;
 - (d) the names and residential addresses of the directors of the professional medical corporation;
 - (e) the names and residential addresses of all licensed medical practitioners practising medicine as employees or on behalf of the corporation;
 - (f) the date of issuance of the original licence to the professional medication corporation;
 - (g) each date of renewal of the licence of the professional medical corporation; and

(h) the other particulars that may be directed by the board or that the registrar considers appropriate.

Corporate records

18.6 A professional medical corporation shall

- (a) maintain current financial records in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles;
- (b) prepare a financial statement at the end of each fiscal year;
- (c) maintain current patient records; and
- (d) maintain, in accordance with generally accepted business standards, records with respect to its employees.

Corporate name

- **18.7** (1) The name of a professional medical corporation shall contain
 - (a) the surnames, or the surnames and a combination of the given names or initials and professional designation, of one or more licensed medical practitioners who hold voting shares in the corporation or who are practising medicine as employees or on behalf of the corporation;
 - (b) the words "Medical Clinic" or words with a similar meaning together with the names referenced in paragraph (a) or together with words establishing a geographic location or area of practice; or
 - (c) other words that indicate in a manner acceptable to the registrar that the corporation is engaged in the practice of medicine.

followed by the words "Professional Medical Corporation" or "Prof. Med. Corp." or the initials "P.M.C."

- (2) The registrar may refuse to accept articles of incorporation or continuation for a corporation or to register articles amending the name of a professional medical corporation where, in the opinion of the registrar,
 - (a) the name is inaccurate or may be misleading;

- (b) the name expresses or implies superiority of qualifications, experience or education over that of other medical practitioners; or
- (c) the name would tend to bring the medical profession into disrepute or otherwise is objectionable in light of professional standards of practice and ethics.

Expiry or revocation of licence

- **18.8** (1) Where a corporate licence expires without renewal or is revoked under section 23.5 of the Act, the registrar shall promptly
 - (a) enter on the corporate registry a memorandum with respect to the expiry or revocation of the licence; and
 - (b) notify the professional medical corporation, all licensed medical practitioners practising medicine as employees or on behalf of the professional medical corporation, and the other parties that the registrar considers appropriate that the licence of the professional medical corporation has expired or has been revoked.
- (2) Upon expiry of a corporate licence without renewal, or the revocation of a licence, under section 23.5 of the Act, the registrar shall determine whether the professional medical corporation is entitled to apply for a new licence and may prescribe conditions under which the licence shall be issued.
- (3) A new licence shall not be issued unless an application for a corporate licence is made in accordance with these regulations and the registrar is satisfied that the corporation has complied with all the conditions applicable to the licence.

Liability for payment of fees

- **18.9** (1) A professional medical corporation is jointly liable for the payment of the annual licensing fee in respect of each medical practitioner holding voting shares in the professional medical corporation and each medical practitioner practising medicine as an employee or on behalf of the corporation.
- (2) Where a professional medical corporation has paid an annual licensing fee in respect of a medical practitioner, the medical practitioner is not liable to pay an annual licensing fee for the year for which the professional medical corporation has paid his or her annual licensing fee.

(3) Where a medical practitioner has paid an annual licensing fee before acquiring voting shares in the professional medical corporation, or before practising medicine as an employee or on behalf of the corporation, the professional medical corporation is not liable to pay the medical practitioner's annual licensing fee for the year for which he or she has paid the fee.

Notice

18.10 A notice required to be given to a professional medical corporation, or to a director, shareholder or employee of a medical corporation, under the Act or these regulations shall be by personal service or by prepaid registered mail to the last address filed with the registrar in relation to an application for corporate licence, an application for renewal of a licence or a notice of change.

PART IX GENERAL

General

18.11 Where notice of an act or thing is required to be given to the registrar or to the board under the Act or these regulations, it shall be in writing and shall be sent by prepaid registered mail addressed to the registrar at the board's office address.

- (e) "electronic seal" means a screened image of the Seal of the Trial Division which is used by software applications authorized by the Registrar that are protected by a password to which only the Registrar or persons designated by the Registrar have access;

- (f) "electronic signature" means a screened image of the signature of a person which is used by authorized applications that are protected by a password to which only the person whose signature is to be electronically reproduced, or a person authorized by that person, has access;
- (g) "judgment claimant" means
 - (i) the Attorney General of the province acting pursuant to section 33 of the *Provincial Offences Act* to enforce, by way of civil judgment, payment of a fine and late payment penalty imposed under a provincial statute,
 - (ii) the Attorney General of Canada or the Attorney General of the province acting pursuant to section 734.6 of the *Criminal Code* to enforce, by way of civil judgment, payment of a fine or forfeiture imposed under a statute of the Parliament of Canada,
 - (iii) the Workplace, Health, Safety and Compensation Commission acting pursuant to section 118 of the Workplace, Health, Safety and Compensation Act to enforce, by way of civil judgment, payment of an assessment made under that Act, and
 - (iv) the Minister of Finance acting pursuant to
 - (A) section 27 of the Mining and Mineral Rights Tax
 - (B) section 29 of the Gasoline Tax Act,
 - (C) section 9 of the *Health and Post-Secondary Education Tax Act*,
 - (D) section 21 of the *Insurance Companies Tax Act*,
 - (E) section 36 of the *Tobacco Tax Act*,
 - (F) section 28 of the Financial Corporations Capital Tax Act,

Entry of judgment

- **5A.02.**(1) Where a judgment claimant seeks to enforce payment of a fine, late payment penalty, forfeiture, assessment or tax by causing a judgment of the Trial Division to be entered against the person liable to pay it, the judgment claimant shall, using the certificate template, file in the registry in the Judicial Centre of St. John's a certificate, verified by the signature or the electronic signature of a designated certifying official, certifying
 - (a) the name and current known address of the person who is subject to and liable to pay the fine, late payment penalty, forfeiture, assessment or tax;
 - (b) the fact that the fine, late payment penalty, forfeiture, assessment or tax as the case may be, was imposed and the amount or amounts thereof as well as the date of imposition and the date when it became payable;
 - (c) the fact that the fine, late payment penalty, forfeiture, assessment or tax or any portion thereof (and if a portion, the amount of that portion) was not paid within the time allowed for payment;

- (d) the amount or amounts for which judgment is sought to be entered; and
- (e) that the person making the certificate has knowledge of the information in the certificate and has been duly authorized to make the certificate and to request that the amount claimed be entered as a judgment or to file it as a judgment of the court.
- (2) Upon the filing of a certificate, the Registrar, either manually or using the approved software, shall
 - (a) assign or cause to be assigned a file number in accordance with rule 5.04(1)(a) and record the date of filing;
 - (b) examine the certificate to be satisfied that
 - (i) the requirements of the applicable legislation for the entry of judgment have been satisfied, and
 - (ii) if the certificate has been filed electronically, that the certificate has been signed by a designated certifying official using an electronic signature;
 - (c) if so satisfied, cause a judgment of the court, in which the judgment claimant shall be described as "Claimant" and the person whom the certificate identifies as the person who owes the fine, late payment penalty, forfeiture, assessment or tax shall be described as "Defendant", to be entered either in conventional form or using the judgment template; and
 - (d) provide a copy of the judgment so entered to the judgment claimant.
- (3) Where he is not satisfied that the requirements of the applicable legislation for the entry of judgment have been satisfied or that the amount claimed is correct or that the person named in the certificate has been correctly named or described, the Registrar may
 - (a) reject the certificate and refuse to enter any judgment;
 - (b) request a further or amended certificate or other document; and

- (c) require the judgment claimant to make an application to court for determination of the matter by a judge.
- (4) A judgment claimant may at any time apply to the court for the entry of judgment or for the determination of any other matter in accordance with this Rule.
- (5) On any application to the court pursuant to rule 5A.02(3)(c) or rule 5A.02(4), the court may order that notice and an opportunity to be heard be given to the person against whom judgment is sought to be entered and to any other person who may be affected by the application.

Filing fees

- **5A.03.**(1) Where a certificate is filed electronically pursuant to this Rule, the judgment claimant shall, no later than the next business day, forward to the registry by ordinary mail or otherwise cause to be delivered to the registry a cheque for the amount of the filing fees that would otherwise be payable for the filing of an originating document under these Rules.
- (2) Where facilities exist, the Registrar so approves and a judgment claimant consents, the payment of filing fees may be effected by a pre-authorized chequing plan arranged with, or an electronic debit charge made to, the banker of the judgment claimant.

Records

- **5A.04.**(1) The Registrar may establish and maintain an electronic data base for the storage of all documents filed electronically pursuant to this Rule and of all judgments entered pursuant to such filings; and where such a data base is maintained, the keeping of records by conventional means may be dispensed with.
- (2) Where a judgment entered pursuant to this Rule is or is to be stored electronically, it shall be deemed to have been properly entered if
 - (a) the judgment is created by using the approved software and any judgment templates associated therewith;

- (b) it has affixed thereto the electronic signature of the Registrar or of any person to whom the duty of the Registrar has been assigned pursuant to section 63(2) of the *Judicature Act*; and
- (c) it has affixed thereto the electronic seal of the court.
- (3) A printed copy of a judgment entered electronically pursuant to this Rule shall be deemed to be a true copy of the judgment so entered, if
 - (a) it is printed from the data base storing the judgment using the approved software; and
 - (b) it is so certified by the Registrar.
- (4) Where a copy of a judgment entered electronically pursuant to this Rule is to be transmitted electronically to another person, it shall be deemed to be a true copy of the judgment so entered if it contains a certificate stating that it is printed from the data base storing the judgment using the approved software and the certificate contains the electronic signature of the Registrar.

Amendments

- **5A.05.**(1) Either before or after entry of judgment pursuant to this Rule, a judgment claimant may amend the certificate or apply to amend any judgment entered pursuant thereto to correct the name of the defendant or the amount of the money claimed by filing a further certificate with the amended information and with an explanation for the error.
- (2) Where the Registrar is satisfied that the error in the original certificate or judgment was a clerical mistake or arose from an accidental mistake or omission, he may make the amendment, and cause an amended judgment to be entered accordingly.

Application to set aside judgment

5A.06. Where a judgment is entered pursuant to this Rule, the person against whom it is entered may apply to the court pursuant to rule 29.13 to set aside or vary the judgment on the grounds that

- (a) there was an error in the certificate or the judgment entered pursuant thereto, as to the amount of money due by that person;
- (b) that person is not the person named in or intended to be affected by the certificate or judgment; or
- (c) the requirements of the applicable legislation for the entry of judgment have not been satisfied,

or on such other grounds as may be appropriate.

1. S.187.1 Added Diving standards

CNLR 1165/96 as amended

1. The *Occupational Health and Safety Regulations* are amended by adding immediately after section 187 the following:

Diving standards

- **187.1** (1) The following standards and code, including amendments to them, respecting diving operations are adopted and constituted as part of these regulations:
 - (a) CAN/CSA-Z275.4-97 "Competency Standard for Diving Operations"; and
 - (b) CAN/CSA-Z275.2-92 "Occupational Safety Code for Diving Operations".
- (2) Diving operations for scientific purposes shall be conducted in accordance with the current Canadian Association for Underwater Science Standard of Practice for Scientific Diving.
- (3) The standard referred to in paragraph (1)(a) takes effect 24 months after the publication of this section in the *Gazette* and the code referred to in paragraph (1)(b) takes effect 6 months after the publication of this section in the *Gazette*.
