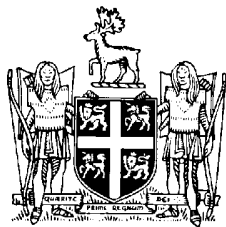

3. (1) A request by an aggrieved party under subsection 13(1) of the *Teacher Training Act* for

- (b) a review by the review panel of the cancellation or suspension, or the refusal to cancel or suspend, a teaching certificate or licence

may be submitted in writing to the registrar or the review panel within 60 days of the date on which the aggrieved party is notified of the decision that gives rise to the request.
