Take notice that St. John's Urban Region Regional Plan Amendment Number 2, 2002, St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 151, 2002 and St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 269, 2002 have been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of St. John's Urban Region Regional Plan Amendment Number 2, 2002, is to redesignate certain lands on Doyle's Road between Back Line and the Robert E. Howlett Memorial Drive to the "Urban Expansion District". Land which is currently located in the St. John's Agriculture Development Area is not affected by this amendment.

In general terms, the purpose of St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 151, 2002 is to redesignate certain lands on Doyle's Road between Back Line and the Robert E. Howlett Memorial Drive to the "Residential Low Density District". Land which is currently

located in the St. John's Agriculture Development Area is not affected by this amendment.

In general terms, the purpose of St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 269, 2002 is to rezone certain lands on Doyle's Road between Back Line and the Robert E. Howlett Memorial Drive to the Residential Low Density (R1) Zone. Land which is currently located in the St. John's Agriculture Development Area is not affected by this amendment.

The St. John's Urban Region Regional Plan Amendment Number 2, 2002, the St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 151, 2002 and the St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 269, 2002 come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. Anyone who wishes to inspect a copy of these amendments may do so at the City of St. John's Engineering and Planning Department, 3rd Floor, St. John's City Hall during regular business hours (Monday through Friday, (9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.).
