

#### **NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR REGULATION 15/03**

Proclamation bringing the Act into force under An Act to Amend the Historic Resources Act (o.c. 2003-044)

(Filed February 17, 2003)

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom, Canada and Her Other Realms and Territories QUEEN, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith.

#### TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

#### GREETING;

#### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 28 of *An Act to Amend the Historic Resources Act*, (the "Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed it expedient that the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT We, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that *An Act to Amend the Historic Resources Act*, shall come into force on February 17, 2003.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF WE have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland and Labrador to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Edward Roberts, Her Majesty's Counsel learned in the law, Lieutenant Governor in and for Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador.

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Short title	<b>1.</b> These regulations may be cited as the <i>Registered Heritage District Regulations</i> .
Application for registration	<b>2.</b> A person, association of persons, whether incorporated or unin- corporated, and a municipality may apply to the foundation for the designation of an area containing a number of buildings or other struc- tures that the applicant considers to be of architectural or historical significance to the province as a registered heritage district.
Description	<b>3.</b> An application under section 2 shall include a description of the area to be included in the registered heritage district.
Resolution of council	<b>4.</b> Where an application under section 2 relates to an area located within a municipality, the application shall be accompanied by a copy of a resolution of the council of the municipality in support of the proposed designation.

Publication of notice of designa- tion	<b>8.</b> The foundation shall provide public notice of the designation by publication of a notice in a newspaper circulating in the area of the designation or by another appropriate means.
