# URBAN AND RURAL PLANNING ACT NOTICE OF REGISTRATION CITY OF MOUNT PEARL DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO . 127, 2003

TAKE NOTICE that the City of Mount Pearl Development Regulations Amendment No. 127, 2003, adopted by Council on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 2003, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment No. 127, 2003 is to revise the development standards to the Shopping Centre (SC) use zone table by adding minimum setback distances for buildings within shopping centre zones that have internal lot line conditions. The amendment also gives the Authority the ability to limit the height of an entrance canopy that may form part of the architectural detailing of a shopping centre. In addition, the amendment adds a number of definitions to the Development Regulations that serve to clarify issues relating to Internal Lot Lines.

The Mount Pearl Development Regulations Amendment No. 127, 2003 comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. Anyone who wishes to inspect a copy of the Mount Pearl Development Regulations No. 127, 2003 may do so at City Hall, City of Mount Pearl during normal working hours.




