NOTICE OF REGISTRATION CITY OF MOUNT PEARL MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 52, 2003 AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 131, 2003

TAKE NOTICE that the City of Mount Pearl Municipal Plan Amendment Number 52, 2003 and Development Regulations Amendment Number 131, 2003, adopted by Council on the 1st day of April, 2003, and approved on the 10th day of June, 2003, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment Number 52, 2003 is to re-designate residential properties located in the area of Forsey Place from Mixed Use to Residential, and to re-designate land to the rear of these residential properties from Mixed Use to Open Space – Recreation.

In general terms, the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment Number 131, 2003 is to re-zone the residential properties located in the area of Forsey Place from Mixed Development (MD) to Residential High Density – Special (RHD-S), and to re-zone the land to the rear of these properties from Mixed Development (MD) to Recreational Open Space (OS). In addition, the title of the Residential – Jubilee Place (R-JP) use zone table shall be replaced by the new title Residential High Density – Special (RHD-S); this use zone shall maintain the existing development regulations but under a new more general name.

The Mount Pearl Municipal Plan Amendment Number 52, 2003 and Development Regulations Amendment Number 131, 2003 come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland & Labrador Gazette*. 
