Take notice that the Town of Paradise Development Regulations Amendment No. 44, 2003 adopted on the 22nd day of July, 2003, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of the Development Regulations Amendment No. 44, 2003, is to re-zone a parcel of land on the corner of Karwood and Kestrel Drive from "Residential Medium Density One" (RMD-1) to "Residential High Density One" (RHD-1) under the Paradise Development Regulations, 1994. Additionally, the Amendment would change the lot area/unit standard for apartment buildings from 200-300 square metres/unit to 120 square metres/unit.

The Town of Paradise Development Regulations Amendment No. 44, 2003 comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*.
