### ST. JOHN'S MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICE COMMERCIAL MAINTENANCE BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF ST. JOHN'S AMENDMENT NO. 1, 2004 BY-LAW

Take notice that the St. John's Municipal Council has enacted an amendment to the Commercial Maintenance By-Law of the City of St. John's.

The said Amendment was passed by Council on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2004 and will amend Section 19 of the Commercial Maintenance By-Law so as to clarify the guard and handrail requirements for porches, landings and similar structures.

All persons are hereby required to take notice that any person who wishes to view such By-Law may view same at the Office of the City Solicitor of the St. John's Municipal Council at City Hall, and that any person who wishes to obtain a copy thereof may obtain it at the said office upon

the payment of a reasonable charge as established by the St. John's Municipal Council for such copy.

other dwelling types as a discretionary use in a Commercial Zone.

**MUNICIPALITIES ACT  
TOWN OF GRAND FALLS-WINDSOR  
TAXI REGULATIONS AMENDMENT No. 6**

The Town of Grand Falls-Windsor Taxi Regulations are amended as follows:-

Regulation 16 is hereby amended by adding Regulation 16 (3) and 16 (4).

16 (3) Every taxi cab operating license shall remain the property of Council.

16 (4) Council shall not issue any more than seven (7) taxi cab operating licenses. If any license in effect as of April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2004 is discontinued by the Holder, Council shall cancel that license and no other taxi cab operating license shall be issued, until the maximum number of licenses issued is five (5).

Regulations 21 (a), 21 (b) and 21 (c) are hereby repealed and substituted.

21 (a) Council shall approve a fleet colour for each holder of a taxi cab operating license.

21 (b) No Holder shall operate a taxi cab that is not of a colour approved by Council.

21 (c) The Taxi Inspector may grant a grace period, as he sees fit, to allow a reasonable period of time for a Holder to change the colour of a taxi cab to that approved by Council.

Regulation 47 is amended by adding Regulation 47 (e).

47 (e) Council shall refuse to renew a taxi operating license when the Holder of a taxi operating License has not paid fines assessed by Provincial Court for violations of the Taxi Regulations approved by the Town.

Repeal and substitute the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor Taxi Regulations to include the following increase to Schedule “A” – Tariff of Fares:-

**TARIFF OF FARES**

For the first 1\10 kilometer or part thereof.....\$2.30  
For each additional 1\10 kilometer.....\$0.14

These fares include H.S.T.

**1. Section 14 of the *Royal Newfoundland Constabulary Regulations* is amended by adding immediately after subsection (1) the following:**

(1.1) Notwithstanding subsection (1), where an accused police officer who is to be tried by a disciplinary panel is not a member of the

bargaining unit, the panel shall consist of 2 persons, who may or may not be police officers, one appointed by the chief of police, or his or her delegate, one appointed by the accused police officer, and a third person, who may or may not be a police officer, appointed by the other 2 appointees, who shall be the chairperson of the panel.

(1.2) Where a person appointed under subsection (1.1) is a police officer, the officer appointed shall not be subordinate to the accused police officer.
