



NLR 114/96 as amended

- 1. Section 41 of the *Pension Benefits Act Regulations* is amended by repealing subsection (4) and substituting the following:
- (4) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the Memorial University Pension Plan is

- (a) exempt for the period from April 1, 2002 until December 31, 2005 from the requirement that the employer pay an amount under paragraph 12(3)(d) of these regulations; and
- (b) exempt from the requirement under paragraph 12(3)(c) of the regulations to liquidate the going concern unfunded liability arising from the cost of providing indexed benefits in relation to past service under section 24.1 of the *Memorial University Pensions Act* within the prescribed 15 year period and is instead permitted to liquidate this liability within 40 years from the day that indexing is effective.

1. S.187.1 Amdt. Diving standards

CNLR 1165/96 as amended

- 1. Section 187.1 of the *Occupational Health and Safety Regulations* is amended by adding immediately after subsection (1) the following:
- (1.1) Notwithstanding paragraph (1)(b), the following modifications to CAN/CSA-Z275.2-92 "Occupational Safety Code for Diving

Operations" apply to seafood harvesting operations for the period of October 8, 2004 to April 30, 2005 inclusive:

- (a) clause 6.4.2 shall be deleted and the following substituted:
  - 6.4.2 When diving in a tethered mode a minimum of 3 workers shall be present at each dive site, one of whom shall be a diver, one a standby diver, and one a diver's tender.
- (b) clause 6.4.3 shall be deleted and the following substituted:
  - 6.4.3 When diving in a free-swimming mode, a minimum of 3 workers shall be present at each dive site, 2 of whom shall be divers and one a diver's tender. Notwithstanding clause 3.4.6, for the purpose of this clause, a standby diver shall not be required when the buddy system referred to in clause 6.5.3 is being followed.

#### **ORDER**

Beginning at a point at the highwater mark on the southern shoreline of White Bear Arm where an unnamed stream enters that arm, more specifically having co-ordinates north 5,846,880 metres and east 563,336 metres;

Then south 50° 12' 17" west 2,700 metres, more or less, to a high point;

Then south 62° 53' 41" west 1,774 metres, more or less, to a high point;

Then south 65° 12' 19" west 1,125 metres, more or less, to a high point;

Then north 74° 53' 21" west 3,852 metres, more or less, to a high point;

Then north 9° 17' 47" west 2,400 metres, more or less, to a high point;

Then north 17° 59′ 12″ west 1,200 metres, more or less, to a high point;

Then north 63° 32' 19" east 3,829 metres, more or less, to a high point;

Then north 89° 12' 3" east 760 metres, more or less, to a point on the southern shoreline of White Bear Arm, more specific having coordinates north 5,850,103 metres and east 558,373 metres;

Then in a generally southwesterly direction following the shoreline of White Bear Arm, passing the Town of Charlottetown, to the point of commencement.

All bearings refer to grid north and as with distances and co-ordinates given are subject to approximation as delineated on the 1:50,000 National Topographic Mapping.

The *Charlottetown Municipal Planning Area*, Consolidated Newfoundland and Labrador Regulation 831/96, is repealed.
