CANADA-NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR OFFSHORE PETROLEUM BOARD CALL FOR BIDS No. NL05-1

The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board hereby gives notice of the bids which have been selected in response to Call for Bids No. NL05-1 in the Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Area.
