TAKE NOTICE that the City of Mount Pearl Municipal Plan Amendment Number 60, 2005 and Development Regulations Amendment Number 156, 2005, adopted by Council on the 25th day of October, 2005, and approved on

the 20th day of December, 2005, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment Number 60, 2005 is to re-designate property at 161 Park Avenue from Institutional to General Commercial. In general terms, the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment Number 156, 2005 is to re-zone this property from Community and Public Services (PB) to Office Building (OB). It also involves related changes to the OB Use Zone Table and the Classification of Uses Table. These amendments would allow for an adaptive re-use of the existing United Pentecostal Church at 161 Park Avenue to be used as a Day Spa/Salon.

The Mount Pearl Municipal Plan Amendment Number 60, 2005 and Development Regulations Amendment Number 156, 2005 come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland & Labrador Gazette*. 
