Take notice that the Town of Paradise Municipal Plan Amendment #3 and Municipal Development Regulations Amendment No. 13 - 2006, adopted on the 2^{nd} day of May 2006 and approved on the 20th day of June 2006, have been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

In general terms, the Municipal Plan Amendment redesignates a parcel of land located off Karwood Drive and corner of Hudsonberry Drive from Commercial Local to Commercial/Light Industrial. The Development Regulations Amendment re-zones the same parcel of land from Commercial Local to Commercial/Light Industrial. The purpose of the amendments is to re-designate lands for future development of a water bottling plant with a front retail sales office.

NOTICE OF REGISTRATION TOWN OF PORTUGAL COVE-ST. PHILIP'S MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 7, 2006 and DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 19, 2006

Take notice that the Town of Portugal Cove-St. Philip's Municipal Plan Amendment No. 7, 2006 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 19, 2006, approved on the 31st. day of May, 2006, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment No. 7, 2006 is to add new policies to the Municipal Plan to enable the development of wind turbine(s), at the discretion of Council, for purposes of generating electricity for personal use. The amendment will give Council discretion to restrict proposals for commercial wind turbine(s) to the Rural Land Use designation.

Development Regulations Amendment No. 19, 2006, will: 1) add to Schedule A, a definition for "wind turbine(s)", which shall include a description of the use and its components; 2) Add to Schedule B, Classification of Uses of Land and Buildings, the term "utilities" as a new land use classification, with "wind turbine(s)" as an example of the new classification; and, 3) Add to Schedule C, Use Zone Tables, "utilities" as a discretionary use, including conditions that shall apply to the development of a wind turbine(s).

The amendment will add wind turbine(s) to the following land use zones: Residential Medium Density (RMD), Residential Infill (RI), Residential Rural (RR), Residential Coastal (RC), Mixed Development (MIX), Public Use (PUB), Light Industrial (LI), Agriculture (AG), and Rural (RUR).
