### NOTICE OF REGISTRATION TOWN OF GAMBO MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT NO 4, 2006 AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 5, 2006

Take notice that the Town of Gambo Municipal Plan Amendment No. 4, 2006 and Development Regulations No. 5, 2006, adopted on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2006, (as amended) and approved on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2006, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment No. 5, 2006 to its Land Use Zoning, Subdivision and Advertisement Regulations in accordance with the proposed amendment to the Municipal Plan 2003-2013 to allow consideration of proposed light industrial uses in the Commercial zone. The amendment would add Light Industrial to the Discretionary Use Classes in the Commercial zone. In accordance with Section 90 of the General Regulations Council may permit the development of a Discretionary Use if it is satisfied that the development would not be contrary to the general intent and purpose of these Regulations or the Municipal Plan, it is given notice of the application in accordance with Regulations 32 and

has considered any objections or representations which may have been received on the matter.

Specifically this amendment is proposed to give council the authority to approve an application made by Assurassay Laboratories to install a rock laboratory in an existing commercial building at 443 Smallwood Blvd. This business will provide services to the mineral exploration industry. The laboratory will have two rock crushers measuring 3 feet x 2 feet x 5 feet. These will process rock samples to be shipped away for analysis. The operation is not expected to generate noise that will be heard outside the building. Dust will be minimized with use of Heppa filters, and the operation will generate minimal traffic.

The Town of Gambo Municipal Plan Amendment No. 5, 2006 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 5, 2006 come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. Anyone who wishes to inspect a copy of the Gambo Municipal Plan Amendment No. 4, 2006 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 5, 2006 may do so at the Town Office, Gambo during normal working hours.


