GREETING;

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by Order in Council OC2006-296 dated July 20, 2006, the Lieutenant Governor in council authorized the following Terms of Reference for a review to be undertaken by the Honourable J. Derek Green, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador (Trial Division):

1. Chief Justice Green is authorized to undertake an independent review and evaluation of the policies and procedures regarding compensation and constituency allowances for Members of the House of Assembly that includes:

- i) An assessment of Members of the House of Assembly (MHA) Constituency Allowances to determine if they are the most effective and efficient vehicle to reimburse MHAs for expenses incurred during the normal execution of their duties;
 - ii) A comparison of all components of compensation of members of the legislature in Newfoundland and Labrador, including but not limited to indemnities, allowances and pensions, with that in other provincial and territorial legislatures in Canada;
 - iii) An evaluation of best practices for compensation of members of legislatures in other provinces and territories; and
 - iv) A determination of whether proper safeguards are in place to ensure accountability and compliance with all rules and guidelines governing payments of all aspects of MHA compensation and Constituency Allowances;
2. The Chief Justice is authorized to undertake an independent review and evaluation of the policies and procedures for control of the types of expenditures reviewed by the Auditor General in his report, "Payments Made by the House of Assembly to Certain Suppliers";
3. A matter that is necessarily incidental to a matter specified above may be included in the review and evaluation by the Chief Justice;
4. The Chief Justice is authorized to develop recommendations on policies and practices resulting from the review and evaluation as outlined above. Additionally, the Chief Justice is authorized to bring forward recommendations that would ensure the accountability and compliance practices employed in the House of Assembly meet or exceed the best in the country. Such recommendations must take into account opportunities to enhance the accountability and transparency of MHA expenditures without undermining the autonomy of the legislature and its elected members;
5. All Minister and Officials of the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador, and its agencies, are to provide the Chief Justice with their complete and unreserved cooperation in all aspects of this review;
6. Recommendations should be brought forward for the consideration of Cabinet as soon as reasonably possible, to enable the House to address any potential legislative and administrative changes in its Fall 2006 session, and
7. The Department of Justice and the Public Service Secretariat, in collaboration with Executive Council and the Department of Finance, are directed to take the necessary actions to provide Chief Justice Green with the necessary resources to undertake this review expeditiously with such resources to include a part-time legal counsel, a part-time accountant, a part-time advisor from Memorial University, an individual to provide administrative and research support, a policy advisor and an actuary.

WHEREAS subsection 2(1) of the "*Public Inquiries Act*" provides as follows:

Where the Lieutenant-Governor in Council considers it expedient to make an inquiry into a matter connected with the peace, order and good government of this province, or the conduct of a part of the public business, or the administration of justice, or into the industries of this province, or into other matters which he or she considers to be for the public good, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may by Commission under the Great Seal appoint the person or persons, called the commissioner or commissioners, that he or she may select to hold the inquiry.

WHEREAS by Order in council OC2006-297 dated July 20, 2006 by Commission under the Great Seal and under the authority of the "*Public Inquiries Act*" the Lieutenant Governor in Council appointed the Honourable J. Derek Green, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador (Trial Division), a Commissioner.

WHEREAS the scope of the Commissioner's inquiry is to summon a witness or witnesses, and to require the witness or witnesses to give evidence orally or in writing upon oath or affirmation, and to produce the documents and things that may be considered necessary within the Terms of Reference identified in OC2006-296 in the limited circumstance where the Chief Justice is unable to obtain the full cooperation of an individual or individuals during the conduct of his review separately ordered by OC2006-296 (reproduced above).

WHEREAS by Order in Council OC2006-511 dated December 6, 2006, the Lieutenant Governor in Council authorized additional time for the completion of the review by the Chief Justice.

NOW THEREFORE by Order in Council OC2007-040 dated February 1, 2007, the Lieutenant Governor in Council authorizes additional time for the completion of the review by the Chief Justice and directs that recommendations be brought forward for the consideration of Cabinet by February 28, 2007, or such later date as may be determined by the Premier in consultation with the

Speaker of the House of Assembly, to enable the House to address any potential legislative and administrative changes in its Spring 2007 session.

AND BE IT ORDERED THAT the Terms of Reference identified in OC2006-296 and OC2006-511 are hereby amended.

HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT

TOWN OF GRAND BANK TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

Pursuant to authority delegated by the Minister of Transportation and Works under the *Highway Traffic Act*, the Town Council of Grand Bank has made the following regulations.

TOWN OF GRAND BANK
Rex C. Matthews, Mayor

REGULATIONS

1. Definitions

- (a) "Act" means the *Highway Traffic Act*.
- (b) Council means the Town Council of Grand Bank.
- (c) "Town" means the Town of Grand Bank
- (d) "Park" means to allow a motor vehicle to remain on a highway in a stationary position whether or not the operator remains in control, provided that a vehicle shall not be deemed to be so parked if it is stopped for the immediate taking up or discharging of passengers or for such time as may be actually necessary for the loading or unloading of goods or for repairing such vehicle when repairs thereto on a highway are necessary.
- (e) "Highway" means a place or way, including a structure forming part of the place or way, designed and intended for, or used by, the public for the passage of traffic and includes all the

Attached is a copy of the schedule of penalties.

- (c) Where a person has been convicted of an offence under paragraphs 2 (b) (i), (ii), (iii) or (iv) is convicted within a period of 2 years of an offence under paragraphs 2 (b) (i), (ii), (iii) or (iv), the new offence shall be considered as a second or subsequent offence for the purpose of the imposition of a penalty.
- 3. No person shall park any vehicle on the highway within the limits of the Town in such a manner as to interfere with, hinder, or obstruct the normal flow of traffic.
- 4. No vehicle shall be parked in a marked crosswalk or within "6 meters" of the approach side of a crosswalk.
- 5. No person shall double park any motor vehicle on any highway within the limits of the Town.
- 6. A driver shall not stop, stand or park a vehicle on a highway other than on the right side of said highway parallel to that side and where there is a curb, with the wheels within 30 centimeters of the curb.
- 7. No person shall park any vehicle used as a taxi on the highway for the purpose of soliciting business, except in a place designated by the Council for the purpose.
- 8. No vehicle shall be parked at a distance less than 6 meters from any intersection within the limits of the Town.
- 9. No person shall park any motor vehicle or allow any motor vehicle to remain in a stationary

- position within 1 meter of any fire plug or hydrant within the limits of the Town.
10. The driver of any commercial motor vehicle loading or unloading freight within the Town shall, if possible, pull such motor vehicle off the highway into some private parking space; where this is not possible the driver shall when loading or unloading freight, pull as near as possible to the curb or side of the road and load or unload as quickly as possible, but in no case shall a driver place a commercial motor vehicle in such a position as to hinder or obstruct the normal flow of traffic.
11. (a) No person shall drive or park any vehicle within "200 meters" of any site within the limits of the Town where a fire is in progress or in such a place as to obstruct in any way the free working of any fire fighting apparatus, except with the permission of a police constable, fireman or municipal peace officer.
- (b) This regulation shall not apply to any fire fighting apparatus, vehicles or police, medical doctors, nurses or to ambulances or fireman's vehicle.
12. The owner or operator of any motor vehicle shall move his vehicle on request to such position and for such time as may be reasonably required by a police officer or municipal "enforcement officer".
13. No person shall leave a vehicle standing upon a highway in such a position that it may:
- (a) constitute a hindrance to the maintenance, repair or improvement of the highway;
- (b) hinder or impede the carrying out of any undertaking of the Council.
14. No person shall park any motor vehicle across the entrance to any driveway within the limits of the Town.
15. (a) A person who has been convicted of an offence under subsection 2(b) is liable to a fine of not more than the maximum and not less than the minimum amount prescribed for the offence in the schedule opposite the number or letters or both of the section, subsection or paragraph and the statement of the offence and in default of payment of the fine to imprisonment for a term not exceeding the maximum period prescribed for that offence in the schedule and appearing there opposite the number or letter of the section, subsection or paragraph and the statement of the offence.
- (b) A person who has been convicted of an offence under these regulations for which a penalty has not been prescribed in the schedule shall be liable on summary conviction.
- (i) Where the offence is a first offence, to a fine of not less than \$30.00 and not more than \$200 and in default of payment of a fine to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 3 months, and
- (ii) Where the offence is a second or subsequent offence to a fine of not less than \$50 and not more than \$500 and in default of payment of a fine to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six (6) months.
16. These regulations were adopted and passed by Council at a meeting held on the 14th day of November, 2006 and will come into effect on the (date of publication in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*), and may be cited as the Town of Grand Bank (Traffic) Regulations, 2006.
17. All previous Traffic Regulations adopted by the Town of Grand Bank are rescinded.
