

1. (1) Paragraph 4(9)(a) of the *Pesticide Control Regulations, 2003* is repealed and the following substituted:

(a) a domestic pesticide to be used on his or her own property;

(2) Section 4 of the regulations is amended by adding immediately after subsection (10) the following:

(11) Notwithstanding subsection (9), subsection (1) and section 5 shall apply to a superintendent of rental properties, a landlord or a lawn care service provider who applies a domestic class pesticide to a property

(a) supervised by that superintendent;

(b) occupied or used by that landlord's tenant; or

(c) for which that lawn care service provider was engaged to provide a service.

(12) Subsection (11) shall come into force one year after its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) Paragraph 5(6)(a) of the regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

(a) a domestic pesticide to the applicator's own property provided that the property is not one to which subsection 4(11) applies;

(2) Section 5 of the regulations is amended by adding immediately after subsection (6) the following:

(7) A licence issued under these regulations may have specified on it the terms and conditions that the minister or his or her delegate may establish.

3. Section 6 of the regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

Unlicensed assistants

6. Notwithstanding subsection 8(6), a pesticide applicator or a pesticide operator using or applying a pesticide under a licence referred to in paragraph 5(1)(a) or (d) may allow a person who does not have a licence to apply a pesticide and shall, with respect to that unlicensed person employed by, contracted to or working with that applicator or operator

- (a) ensure that that person, when carrying out activities under the Act or regulations, is under his or her direct supervision and control; and
- (b) be responsible for the actions and conduct of that person with respect to anything required to be carried out in accordance with the Act or regulations.

4. (1) Subsection 7(2) of the regulations is amended by adding immediately after the word "agricultural" the words "or greenhouse".

(2) Subsection 7(4) of the regulations is amended by deleting the words "domestic pesticides and a".

(3) Section 7 of the regulations is amended by adding immediately after subsection (4) the following:

(4.1) After December 31, 2006, a vendor of domestic pesticides shall not sell pesticide and fertilizer products that are blended together.

(4) Section 7 of the regulations is amended by adding immediately after subsection (10) the following:

(11) After December 31, 2009, a vendor shall not sell a domestic pesticide to a person unless, during business hours, that vendor has on the premises from which that pesticide is sold at least one employee who is certified by the minister to sell domestic pesticides.

(12) Subsection 11 does not apply to a vendor who sells

- (a) less than 200 litres of liquid formulation; or
- (b) less than 200 kilograms of solid formulation; or

- (c) less than an equivalent combined amount of formulation described in paragraph (a and (b),

of a domestic pesticide in a calendar year.

(13) The minister may establish terms and conditions that are to apply to activities carried out under a licence and those terms and conditions shall be indicated on that licence.

5. (1) Subsection 8(3) of the regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a commercial or restricted pesticide may be purchased from a vendor who is located outside the province and who does not have a licence if the licensed operator obtains a permit for the purchase of the pesticide from the minister, or a person designated by the minister.

(2) Subsection 8(5) of the regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

(5) Notwithstanding subsections (1), (2) and 7(2), a vendor may sell a commercial pesticide or a restricted pesticide to a pesticide operator who does not have a licence where

- (a) the pesticide is designated on its label as being for agricultural use; or
- (b) the pesticide is designated on its label as being for greenhouse use; and
- (c) the vendor maintains records of that sale of pesticide as required by the minister.

(6) A pesticide

- (a) designated for agricultural use and sold under paragraph (5)(a) may be applied only by a person having an applicator's licence referred to in paragraph 5(1)(a) and an operator's licence referred to in section 4; and
- (b) designated for greenhouse use and sold under paragraph (5)(b) may be applied only by a person having an applica-

tor's licence referred to in paragraph 5(1)(d) and an operator's licence referred to in section 4.

6. The regulations are amended by adding immediately after section 8 the following:

Exemptions and
prohibitions re: sale
and application

8.1 (1) Notwithstanding sections 4, 5 and 7, a person may apply or sell a pesticide listed in Schedule A of these regulations without holding a licence under those sections.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a person shall not apply a pesticide in an area that is a public space unless that person is applying a pesticide listed in Schedules A and B and provided that that application is done in accordance with these regulations.

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (2), where it is considered necessary to apply a pesticide not listed in Schedule A or Schedule B of these regulations in a public space that is a recreational or sport area, that application may be carried out twice annually.

(4) Notwithstanding subsection (2), a person may, in accordance with these regulations, apply a rodenticide in a public space.

(5) Notwithstanding subsection (2), a person may,

(a) where he or she holds an applicator's licence under section 5, apply a pesticide not listed in Schedule A or B in a public space that is a building where that building will not be in use for 48 or more hours after the application of that pesticide;

(b) where he or she holds a special use licence under section 8.2 and an applicator's licence under section 5, apply a pesticide not listed in Schedule A or B in a public space that is a building where that building will be in use after the application of that pesticide.

(6) In this section a public space includes property that is a

(a) property of the government of the province;

(b) property of the government of Canada, in accordance with subsection 3(2) of the Act;

- (c) hospital or nursing home listed in the Schedule to the *Hospitals Act*;
- (d) personal care home as defined in the *Personal Care Home Regulations*;
- (e) school operating under the *Schools Act, 1997*, the college operating under the *College Act, 1996*, a private training institution operating under the *Private Training Institutions Act* and the Memorial University of Newfoundland established under the *Memorial University Act*;
- (f) place where there is a child care service operating under the *Child Care Services Act*; and
- (g) green space, including parks, sport fields, ball fields, soccer pitches and public swimming pools except for the applications referred to in subparagraph 4(9)(c)(v).

Special use licence

8.2 (1) A person may apply to the minister for and the minister may issue to that person a special use licence for the application of pesticides under section 8.1.

(2) A licence issued under subsection (1) is limited to the terms, conditions, time, place and purpose that the minister may approve.

7. Subsection 11(5) of the regulations is repealed.

8. Section 13 is amended by adding immediately after subsection (2) the following:

(3) After December 31, 2009, a vendor or licensed pesticide operator shall not store a commercial pesticide or a restricted pesticide on the premises of a private dwelling place unless that storage has been first approved by an inspector with the department authorized to give that approval.

9. The regulations are amended by adding immediately after section 13 the following:

Penalty

13.1 Where, with respect to a contravention of these regulations,

- (a) a summons is issued to a person by way of a ticket in accordance with the *Provincial Offences Act*; and
- (b) that person is, on summary conviction, found guilty of the offence stated on that ticket,

that person is liable to a fine as described in Schedule C of these regulations.

10. The regulations are amended by adding immediately after section 15 the following:

- rotenone (Domestic) to control insects found on garden flowers and vegetables
- silica aerogel, also referred to as silica gel, amorphous silica gel (Domestic) to control ants, earwigs and other crawling insects

- soaps (Domestic) to control insects found on garden flowers and vegetables
- tetramethrin (Domestic & Commercial) to control house and garden insects

1. Section 19 of the *Child Support Guidelines Regulations* is repealed and the following substituted:

Application for
child support

19. (1) An applicant for a child support order whose income information is necessary to determine the amount of the order shall provide to the court and the opposing respondent

- (a) a copy of every personal income tax return filed by him or her for each of the 3 most recent taxation years;
- (b) a copy of every notice of assessment and reassessment issued to him or her for each of the 3 most recent taxation years;
- (c) where he or she is an employee, the most recent statement of earnings indicating the total earnings paid in the year to date, including overtime or, where a statement is not provided by the employer, a letter from his or her employer setting out that information including his or her rate of annual salary or remuneration;
- (d) where he or she is self employed, for the 3 most recent taxation years
 - (i) the financial statements of his or her business or professional practice, other than a partnership, and
 - (ii) a statement showing a breakdown of all salaries, wages, management fees or other payments or benefits paid to or on behalf of, persons or corporations with whom he or she does not deal at arm's length;
- (e) where he or she is a partner in a partnership, confirmation of his or her income and draw from, and capital in, the partnership for its 3 most recent taxation years;
- (f) where he or she controls a corporation, for the 3 most recent taxation years
 - (i) the financial statements of the corporation and its subsidiaries, and
 - (ii) a statement showing a breakdown of all salaries, wages, management fees or other payments or benefits paid to, or on behalf of, persons or corporations with whom the corporation, and every related corporation, does not deal at arm's length;

- (g) where he or she is a beneficiary under a trust, a copy of the trust settlement agreement and copies of the trust's 3 most recent financial statements; and
- (h) where the parent receives income from employment insurance, social assistance, a pension, workers' compensation, disability payments or other source, the most recent statement of income indicating the total amount of income from the applicable source during the current year, or if such a statement is not provided, a letter from the appropriate authority stating the required information.

(2) A person who is served with an application for a child support order and whose income information is necessary to determine the amount of the order, shall, within 30 days after the application is served if the person resides in Canada or the United States or within 60 days if he or she resides elsewhere, or the other time limit that the court specifies, provide the court as well as the applicant or another person, if there is one, with the documents referred to in subsection (1).

(3) Where, in the course of proceedings in respect of an application for a child support order, an applicant requests an amount to cover expenses referred to in subsection 7(1) or pleads undue hardship, the applicant shall, within 30 days after the amount is sought or undue hardship is pleaded if the applicant resides in Canada or the United States or within 60 days if he or she resides elsewhere, or the other time limit that the court specifies, provide the court and the respondent with the documents referred to in subsection (1).

(4) Where, in the course of proceedings in respect of an application for support of a child, it is established that the income of the parent who would be paying the amount of child support is greater than \$150,000, the other parent shall, within 10 days after the income is established to be greater than \$150,000 if the other parent resides in the province, within 30 days if the other parent resides in another province of Canada or in the United States of America or within 60 days if the other parent resides elsewhere, or the other time limit that the court specifies, provide the court and the parent with the documents referred to in subsection (1).

(5) Nothing in this section precludes the making of rules by a competent authority respecting the disclosure of income information

that is considered necessary for the purposes of the determination of an amount for an order for support of a child.

(6) In this section

- (a) "applicant" means a parent or other person who applies under Part III of the Act for an order for support of a child;
- (b) "application" means an application for an order for support of a child made under Part III of the Act; and
- (c) "respondent" means a parent against whom an application is made for an order for support of a child.


