GRAFFITI, LOITERING, PUBLIC BEHAVIOR & VANDALISM REGULATIONS

TAKE NOTICE that the Mount Pearl City Council has enacted the City of Mount Pearl Graffiti, Loitering, Public Behavior and Vandalism Regulations.

The said Regulations were passed by Council on the 16th day of October 2007 and will have the effect of prohibiting graffiti, vandalism or loitering within the City in accordance with Sections 278, 279 and 280 of the City of Mount Pearl Act.

Those found in contravention of these regulations can be banned from City facilities, including parks and open spaces for periods of up to one (1) year, and upon being found guilty to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or in default of payment of a fine to a period of imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days or to both a fine and imprisonment.


