#### TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

#### GREETING;

#### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 77 of "An Act to Provide the Public with Access to Information and Protection of Privacy," SNL2002 cA-1.1, (the "Act"), it is provided that the Act or provisions of the Act shall come into force on a day or days to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that certain provisions of the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare that Part IV of "An Act to Provide the Public with Access to Information and Protection of Privacy,", SNL2002 cA-1.1, shall come into force on the date of publication in The Newfoundland and Labrador Extraordinary Gazette.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly. IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF WE have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland and Labrador to be hereunto affixed.

> WITNESS: Our trusty and well-beloved the Honourable Edward Roberts, one of Her Majesty's Counsel learned in the law, Lieutenant Governor in and for Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador.

> AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in Our City of St. John's this 15th day of January, in the year of Our Lord two thousand and eight and in the fiftysixth year of Our Reign.
