

A PROCLAMATION

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE in Our City of St. John's this 15th day of January, in the year of Our Lord two thousand and eight and in the fifty-sixth year of Our Reign.
