ORDER

RESPECTING A FEASIBILITY REPORT

I, Dave Denine, Minister of Municipal Affairs, pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipalities Act*, cM-24,S SNL 1999 as amended make the following Order:

- 1. A Feasibility Report shall be prepared to consider the proposal by the Town of Long Harbour-Mount Arlington Heights to extend the municipal boundary to take in the full extent of the Town's Municipal Planning Area, including the protected water supply area (known as Shingle Pond and/or Trout Pond) and the full site of the Voisey's Bay nickel commercial processing plant.
- 2. Mr. Ken Kelly is hereby appointed as the commissioner to prepare the said Feasibility Report.

3. The Feasibility Report shall be prepared in accordance with the provisions of the *Municipalities Act* and shall be completed and submitted to me within 30 days of the scheduled date of the public hearing.







6.1 (1) In this section, "alcoholic liquor" means alcoholic liquor as defined in the *Liquor Control Act*.

(2) A person shall not possess or consume alcoholic liquor within Barachois Pond Provincial Park from 12:00 noon on Friday, May 16, 2008 to 12:00 noon Monday, May 19, 2008.

(3) A person shall not possess or consume alcoholic liquor within Notre Dame Provincial Park from 12:00 noon on Friday to 12:00 noon on the immediately following Monday during the period of May 16 to June 23, 2008.
