Local Service District of Hillview-Adeytown-Hatchet Cove-St. Jones Within under the Municipalities Act, 1999

1. Section 22 of the *Milk Regulations*, 1998 is repealed and the following substituted:

Minimum price for

22. The minimum price at which milk shall be bought, sold or offered for sale FOB registered processors premises in the province shall be \$104.45 per hectolitre of standard milk containing 3.6 kilograms of butterfat, and for every kilogram in excess of that butterfat content, the minimum price shall be adjusted by the amount of \$3.20 per hectolitre.

2. These regulations come into force on July 1, 2008.

1. The Newfoundland and Labrador T'Railway Provincial Park Proclamation is amended by adding at the end of the Schedule the following:

The area described in this Schedule is decreased by removing the following parcel of land:

All that piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being west of the Conception Bay Highway, in the Town of Holyrood, in the Electoral District of Harbour Main, in the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, Canada and being more particularly described as follows:

- (iv) partial dentures including laboratory fees, up to \$360,
- (v) an immediate post extraction insertion, up to \$532,
- (vi) a reline including laboratory fees, up to \$211, and
- (vii) repairs at an amount of \$42 per 15 minutes to maximum of \$120; or
- (b) the maximum amounts where denture service is provided by a denturist are, for
 - (i) an upper set, up to \$580,
 - (ii) a lower set, up to \$580,
 - (iii) a complete set, including upper and lower set, up to \$931.
 - (iv) a re-line, up to \$127,
 - (v) repairs at an amount of \$34 per 15 minute maximum, up to \$90; and
 - (vi) partial dentures, including laboratory fees, up to \$300.

Short title

1. This regulation may be cited as the *Student Financial Assistance Board of Directors Regulations*.

Definitions

2. In these regulations,

- (a) "Act" means the Student Financial Assistance Act;
- (b) "board" means the board of directors of the corporation; and
- (c) "corporation" means the Student Loan Corporation of Newfoundland and Labrador established under section 14.1 of the Act.

Composition of board of directors

- **3.** (1) There shall be 5 directors on the board of directors of the corporation.
- (2) The directors of the board shall be, by virtue of their positions, the
 - (a) Deputy Minister of the Department of Education, who shall also be chair of the board;
 - (b) the Deputy Minister of the Department of Finance;
 - (c) the Comptroller General;
 - (d) the Assistant Deputy Minister (Advanced Studies) of the Department of Education; and
 - (e) the Assistant Deputy Minister (Corporate Services) of the Department of Education.
