CANADA-NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR OFFSHORE PETROLEUM BOARD CALL FOR BIDS No. NL07-2

The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board hereby gives notice of the bids which were selected in response to Call for Bids No. NL07-2 in the Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Area. Take notice that the Town of Birchy Bay Municipal Plan Amendment No. 2, 2008 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2008, approved by Council on the 16th day of July, 2008, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

In general terms, Municipal Plan Amendment No. 2, 2008, will re-designate three areas of land along Main Street, Birchy Bay. Area 1 will re-designate an area of land north of Main Street from Rural to Residential. Area 2 will re-designate an area of land north of Main Street and east of Area 1, from Commercial to Residential. Area 3 will re-designate an area of land south of Main Street and areas 1 and 2, from Residential to Mixed Development. The Amendment will also add policy to the Municipal Plan to allow remote seasonal cottages in the Rural Land Use Designation.

Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2008, will rezone the same three areas of land. Area 1 will re-zone an area of land north of Main Street from Rural to Residential. Area 2 will re-zone an area of land north of Main Street and east of Area 1, from Commercial to Residential. Area 3 will re-zone an area of land south of Main Street and areas 1 and 2, from Residential to Mixed Development. The Amendment will allow also add remote seasonal cottages as a discretionary use to the Rural Land Use Zone.

The Town of Birchy Bay Municipal Plan Amendment No. 2, 2008 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2008, comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR REGULATION 54/08

Central Regional Service Board Regulations under the Regional Service Boards Act

(Filed September 30, 2008)

Under the authority of section 9 of the *Regional Service Boards Act*, I make the following regulations.

Short title

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Central Regional Service Board Regulations*.

Definition

2. In these regulations, "board" means the Central Regional Service Board.

Prescribed services

3. The board has the power to construct, acquire, maintain and operate solid waste disposal sites and solid waste management facilities and systems within the central region.

User fees

- **4.** (1) The board has power to charge user fees to a municipality, local service district or unincorporated area in the Central Region as constituted by section 2 of the *Central Regional Service Board Order*, or another municipality, local service district, unincorporated area or other user of a facility or service provided by the board.
- (2) An amount owing under subsection (1) is a debt due to the board and the board may recover it by civil action in a court.

Withdrawal of service

5. The board may stop providing a service to a user of it where the user fails to comply with a policy of the board respecting the service.

- 1. Section 3 of the *Northern Peninsula Regional Service Board Regulations* is amended by renumbering it as subsection 3(1) and by adding immediately after that subsection the following:
- (2) The board has the power to provide fire protection services to the portion of the Northern Peninsula Region defined as the towns,

local service districts and unincorporated areas from Eddies Cove in the north to Anchor Point in the south.

2. Subsection 4(1) of the regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

4. (1) The board has power to charge user fees to a municipality, local service district or unincorporated area in the Northern Peninsula Region as constituted by section 2 of the *Northern Peninsula Regional Service Board Order*, or another municipality, local service district, unincorporated area or other user of a facility or service provided by the board.
