The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board hereby gives notice of a call for the submission of bids in respect of one parcel in the Newfoundland and Labrador offshore area.

This notice of the Call for Bids No. NL09-01 is made pursuant and subject to the *Canada-Newfoundland Atlantic Accord Implementation Act*, S.C., 1987, c. 3, and the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Newfoundland and Labrador Act*, R.S.N.L. 1990, c. C-2.

The following is a summary of the Call for Bids No. NL09-01:

- (i) Sealed bids will be received by the Board prior to the time of closing of this call for bids. This call for bids will close at 4:00 p.m., Newfoundland Standard Time, on **November 19, 2009**, except as specifically provided for in the Call for Bids No. NL09-01;

- (ii) All bids must be submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Call for Bids No. NL09-01;
- (iii) The parcel is located offshore Newfoundland and Labrador and are described in Schedule I. An Exploration Licence may be issued for this parcel;

### NOTICE OF REGISTRATION ST. JOHN'S MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 67, 2009 AND ST. JOHN'S DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 456, 2009

Take notice that St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 67, 2009 and St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 456, 2009 adopted on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2009 and approved on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2009 have been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 67, 2009 is to redesignate the former Federal Government Lands in Pleasantville to the Residential High Density Land Use District, the Residential Medium Density Land Use District, the Open Space Land Use District and the Commercial General Land Use District.

In general terms, the purpose of St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 456, 2009 is to rezone the former Federal Government Lands in Pleasantville to the Residential Medium Density (R-2B-Pleasantville) Zone, the Apartment High Density (A3) Zone, the Commercial – Pleasantville (CM-Pleasantville) Zone and the Open Space (O) Zone.

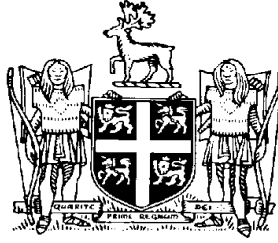

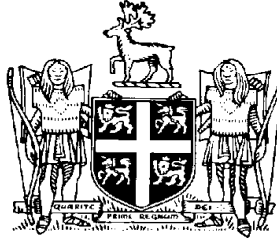

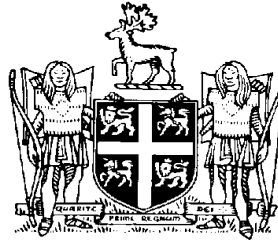
