Take notice that the TOWN OF DEER LAKE Municipal Plan Amendment No.6, 2009 and Development Regulations Amendment No.6, 2009 as adopted on the 28th day of July, 2009 and approved by Council on the 14th day of September, 2009, have been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

The amendments are designed to accommodate residential development on a property currently situated on River Bank Road, by redesignating and rezoning the property from Resort to Residential.

NOTICE OF REGISTRATION TOWN OF PILLEY'S ISLAND MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 1, 2009, AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 2, 2009

Take notice that the TOWN OF PILLEY'S ISLAND Municipal Plan Amendment No. 1, 2009 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2009, as approved by Council on the 1st day of September, 2009 has been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

In general terms, Municipal Plan Amendment No. 1, 2009 consists of six parts: Part A will redesignate an area of land from Residential to Mixed Development; Part B will

redesignate an area of land from Recreation to Mixed Development; Part C will redesignate an area of land from Recreation to Rural and Resource; Part D will redesignate an area of land from Commercial to Mixed Development; Part E will redesignate an area of land from Rural and Resource to Mixed Development; and Part F will delete Commercial Policies Section 3.2.7 of the Municipal Plan.

Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2009 also consists of six parts and will re-zone the same area of land: Part A will rezone an area of land from Residential to Mixed Development; Part B will rezone an area of land from Recreation to Mixed Development; Part C will rezone an area of land from Recreation to Rural and Resource; Part D will rezone an area of land from Commercial to Mixed Development; Part E will rezone an area of land from Rural and Resource to Mixed Development; and Part F will delete the Commercial Land Use Zone Table found in Schedule C.

The Town of Pilley's Island Municipal Plan Amendment No. 1, 2009 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2009, comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. Proclamation bringing certain provisions of the Act into force under An Act to Amend the Securities Act (O.C. 2009-319)

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

GREETING;

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 31 of *An Act to Amend the Securities Act* SNL 2008 c44, (the "Act") it is provided that paragraphs 1(1)(a), (c), (e) and (g), and sections 4 to 12, 15, 21 and subsections 30(1) and (2) shall come into force on a day or days to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that these sections of the Act shall now come into force.

NOW KNOW YE, that We by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that:;

Paragraphs 1 (1) (a), (c), (e) and (g), and sections 4 to 12, 15, 21 and subsections 30(1) and (2) shall come into force on October 30, 2009.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF WE have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Newfoundland and Labrador to be hereunto affixed.
