The minimum width of the wider sideyard on a lot will be reduced from 6.6 metres to 3.0 metres. To ensure no addition to a mobile home is erected too close to another building, the amendment will establish a minimum separation of 3.09 metres between all buildings.

The TOWN OF GAMBO Development Regulations Amendment No. 12, 2010 comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. 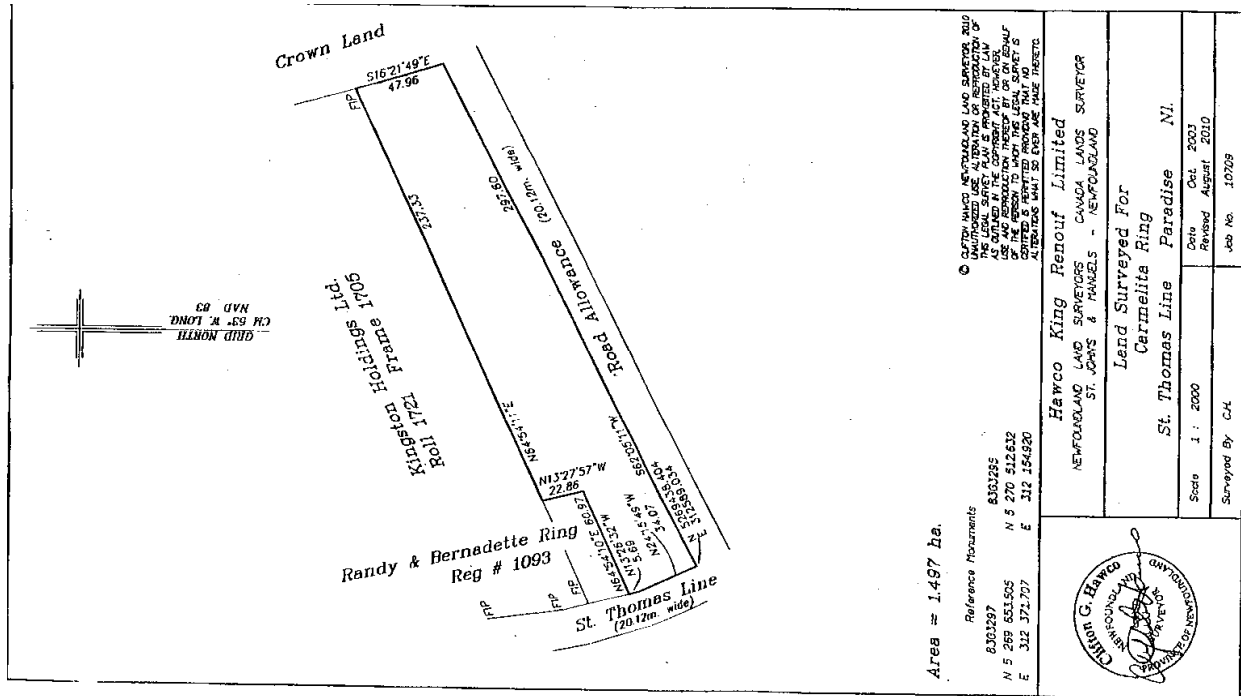

(4) Deficiencies identified during an inspection conducted according to this section shall be corrected within 30 days or the registration of the system shall be revoked by the administrator.
