- (b) a wilderness trail running across the interior of the Avalon Peninsula from Ferryland to Placentia and from Hawks Nest Pond following the Avalon Wilderness Boundary to Butter Pot Hill and to Renew's

including Crown land and privately owned land, and being generally described on maps filed with the Lands Branch of the Department of Environment and Conservation, is designated as a trail to which this Act applies.
