The effect of these changes is to replace the current municipal plan and development regulations texts and maps.



Protected Road Zoning Regulations (Amendment) under the Urban and Rural Planning Act, 2000

(Filed July 6, 2011)

Under the authority of section 32 and section 36 of the *Urban and Rural Planning Act*, I make the following regulations.

1. S.23 R&S Frontage

CNLR 996/96 as amended

1. Section 23 of the *Protected Road Zoning Regulations* is repealed and the following substituted:

Frontage

- **23.** (1) A residential, commercial or public building shall not be erected unless the lot fronts directly upon a highway or other publicly maintained road.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, in exceptional circumstances, approve the issuance of a permit by the authority for the erection of a residential, commercial or

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public building on a lot that does not front directly upon a highway or other publicly maintained road.
